The 18th annual World Export Development Forum will be hosted by the International Trade Centre in conjunction with the Ministry of Commerce, Trade and Industry of Zambia in Lusaka, Zambia from 11th to 13th September 2018. The event will focus on best practices in scaling up trade and investment in Africa, and spotting innovative opportunities in and beyond the region.

The WEDF also features business-to-business meetings which focus on illustrating how investment, trade and open markets can support inclusive development and help achieve the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. Additionally, the Forum will present an opportunity to launch the She Trades Initiative which is a web based application that aims to connect one million women entrepreneurs to international markets by 2020.
